Good Neighbour Schemes respond to the needs of local people by providing help with activities such as:

- \* Befriending, home visiting, companionship or social outings
- \* Caring for pets during holidays or illness
- \* Errands and shopping
- \* Filling in forms, writing letters or reading
- \* Giving lifts to a GP surgery, clinic, hospital or day centre
- \* Household tasks
